

New application for extended producer responsibility


On January 1, 2020, the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will launch a new application for reporting of producer responsibility. The new IT system will have login with e-ID. Approved solutions are:

- BankID
- Telia
- Freja eID +
- Foreign eID
- BankID Norge

The Swedish Tax Agency uses our login service and has foreign eID as the login method on its website. If you want to test your e-credentials, you can do so at:

Select “logga in” the upper right corner and then foreign eID as the login method. Then you choose which country to log in from / which country the e-identification was issued. The following countries in the picture have been approved by Sweden connect and can log in with foreign e-identification.

- appoint a person with a valid E-ID to report for you or
- send an e-mail to producentansvar@naturvardsverket.se and the Swedish EPA will give you a form to fill in instead.
